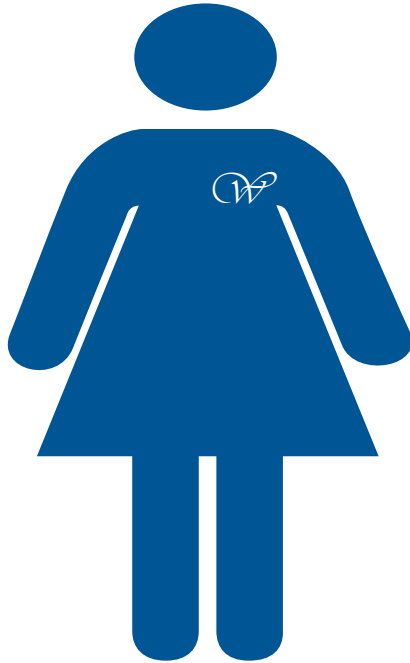


March — Women's History Month
